

# P2000 9mm GPM (German Police Model)

A recent addition to the Heckler & Koch handgun line, the P2000 incorporates features of the successful HK USP Compact pistol with the latest innovations of HK engineers. Designed especially for European police agencies, the P2000 uses the trigger system introduced in 2001 on the USP Compact "Law Enforcement Modification" model.

This unique pre-cocked hammer system combines the advantages of a cocked striker component (constant level of trigger pull and short trigger travel from first to last round fired) with the a double action hammer system.

This ensures an extremely safe pistol with regard to unintended firing and, in case of failure to ignite, the possibility of a second or third trigger pull without the need of first pulling the slide back to re-cock the system.

A set of easy-to-install modular grips insert

allow the P2000 to be custom-fitted to any shooter's hand. Ambidextrous slide release levers and magazine release levers make handling the P2000 natural and easy for right and left-handed shooters.

This modular design approach means the P2000 GPM can be fitted to the individual requirements of virtually any shooter.

A highly reliable, safe, durable, and accurate compact pistol with significant ergonomics features, the P2000 is currently available in 9mm with a caliber .40 S&W model planned.

Significant features include:

- Modular grip with exchangeable back straps to easily adjust the grip size to the shooter's hand
- Ideal size and weight to comply with the requirements of the full range of police missions, including concealed carry
- Set of mounting grooves molded into the polymer frame for installing accessory lights and laser aimers
- Ambidextrous slide release (located on both sides of the frame)
- Ambidextrous magazine release

- Low profile slide and slimline, compact dimensions
- Advanced design with contoured external surfaces to avoid snagging on holster and clothing
- Polymer recoil absorber bushing (similar to the HK USP COMPACT) aids in recoil reduction
- Very short trigger reset distance to enhance the speed of multiple or follow-up shots
- Polygonal cold-hammer forged barrel for less barrel wear, better gas seal behind the bullet, and easier bore cleaning
- Rubber magazine floorplates to reduce damage to magazines and pistol in case of being dropped

# AG-C 40mm Grenade Launcher

Developed from HK's famous line of single shot 40mm launchers, the lightweight AG-C Add-on Grenade Launcher uses a fast and easy side-loading breech configuration. This feature, and the quick detachable design of the HK

aiming point reticle that is illuminated with tritium for use at night.

A model of the AG-C equipped with a add-on buttstock is under development for stand-alone use. A ranging fire control system for

AG-C Add-on Grenade Launcher provides superior combat capability over existing M203 grenade launchers.

The AG-C has been operationally deployed with British Special Operations Forces for the past two years with excellent feed back received.

The AG-C can be installed in seconds on the lower, "6 o'clock" MIL-STD-1913 rail of the M4A1 modular rail system using no special tools.

A unique optional glass block reflex sight provides a single

precise first round engagements at all ranges is also being developed. A version for use on the U.S. M16A2 Rifle, termed the "AG-NL", is presently serving with the Dutch Army, and is also available.

The AG-C can fire all standard low velocity 40 x 46 mm ammunition, including HE, AP, anti-riot baton, irritant gas, and illuminating rounds. Its rifled aluminum barrel ensures a high degree of accuracy out to ranges of 400 meters. An ambidextrous safety lever and double action only trigger ensure easy and safe handling.
