An optional Bruegger & Thomet (B&T) "IMPULS IIA" stainless steel screw-on sound suppressor is matched to the pistol via the last 3 digits of the weapons serial number when they are assembled together at the factory.

The B&T sound suppressor was developed specifically for use on the HK USP9 pistol and

has its own separate serial number. It is possible to reduce the sound signature by an additional 1 to 3 dBs over that of the dry sound suppressor by adding 5 cc's of water to the sound suppressor baffles. It will also help reduce the first round pop often experienced with a dry sound suppressor. This water will help cool the hot propellant gases and will last for 20 shots or 12-24 hours.
